NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the relevant Class Associations.
- 1.2 The Grafham Water S.C. Open Meeting Instructions will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The event is designated Category C.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry is open to 49ers, 59ers, Musto Skiffs, B14s, 29ers and 420s.
- 2.2 Eligible Boats may enter by completing an entry form available at the Race office on Saturday morning, or by completing the form available on the GWSC website and sending it, complete with entry fee, to the GWSC Secretaries office at the address shown above.
- 2.3 Entry fees per boat will be £20 for Musto Skiffs £23 for 49ers, 59ers, B14s, 420s and 29ers.

3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND RACING FORMAT

- 3.420s and 29ers will sail on a separate track from 49ers, 59ers, Musto Skiffs and B14s.
- 3.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration will be held at the GWSC Race Office from 09.30 on Saturday. Competitor's briefing will be at 11.00 am Saturday morning in the downstairs wetbar.
- 4.2 A maximum of four back to back races are scheduled for Saturday with the first race warning not before 11.55. A maximum of three back to back races are scheduled for Sunday with the first race warning not before 10.40.

5 SCORING

- 5.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series and there will be one discard when four or more races have been completed.

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 6.1 Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

8 INSURANCE

- 8.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 for any one accident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat.
